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Riesling Dürnsteiner Kellerberg 2015
Qualitätswein 2015, WACHAU

Location : The Dürnsteiner Kellerberg is probably one of the most well-known locations in Wachau. Not only does it characterize the world-famous landscape of Dürnstein, it also provides the foundation for particularly intense Rieslings. Weathered gneiss, the most common rock in this area, stamps the site's meager, sandy soil.

Grape variety: 100% Riesling

Age of the grapes: 25years

Vintage: 26^h of Oct. 2015

Vinification: The grapes were crushed and pressed carefully for about three hours.

Yeast: Only natural yeast, no addition of selected yeasts

Fermentation: In stainless steel tanks until end of May 2016, under normal cellar temperatures

Maturation: fermentation was followed by maturation on the fine lees until filling.

Filtration: just one coarse filtration before filling

Filling: Sept. 2016

Analysis: Alcohol content: 13 % by volume
Residual sugar: 3g / l

Acidity: 5,7g / l

Tasting notes: Fragrant and flowery Riesling, notes of fresh vineyard peaches and quinces, accompanied by a very delicate blossom fragrance. Refreshing citrus notes in the finish very complex structure based on spice and fine minerality. A typical wine for real Riesling freaks! !
